




The brand was created 1881 by Calixte Ferrier, and was taken on by three young Marseillais who opened their first workshop, La Grande Savonnerie on the Old Port of Marseilles.

This unique concept store really is a place where the know-how and passion which motivate our Master Soapmaker are handed down. He may be the youngest of his trade in France, but it is a point of honour for him to respect the traditions of the first Master soapmakers of Marseilles.

La Grande Savonnerie offers you the chance to discover (or rediscover!) Marseilles soaps through fun workshops during which you can learn about the history of soap in Marseilles and the secrets of the recipe while you make your very own Marseilles soap.

Story

During the early 20th century, aniseed- & fennel-driven spirits were exceedingly popular in the South of France - namely absinthe. In 1914, absinthe was banned in France, leading merchants to produce homemade mixtures. They called "pastis" meaning a "mixture" or "mess" in Provençal French.

In 1932, Paul Ricard officially introduced his unique recipe of pastis to the market as "Ricard, Pastis de Marseille." For 82 years, the original recipe has remained unchanged.

Company presentation

The Ricard Company was founded in 1932 by Paul Ricard. In 1975, it merged with the company Pernod to create the Pernod

Ricard Group. Although they were competitors on the French market, the two companies decided to join forces in order to conquer new international markets.

Since it was formed, Pernod Ricard has developed steadily through organic growth and successive acquisitions.

Today, Pernod Ricard is the world's co-leader in Wines & Spirits with a presence in over 75 countries.

FACTORY AND MUSEUM OF THE CALISSENS DU ROY RENE



The Calissons du Roy René, the story of a family in Provence.

The Calisson d'Aix is recognised as part of the heritage of the city of Aix-en-Provence and more widely as one of the gastronomic icons of Provence. The uninitiated as well as enthusiasts will enjoy this voyage to the heart of the authentic taste of the Calisson in the magic kingdom of Roy René, soon to celebrate its centenary.

10 minutes from the centre of Aix-en-Provence, surrounded by young almond trees, stands the new factory of the Confiserie du Roy René and the Museum of the Calisson. In this location, suspended between past and present, visitors can see the almond trees blossom, the harvesting process, find out about the raw materials, the stages of the production process and follow the production of a batch of Calissons in real time.
